

HEALING THE LAND

Week 4

1. **"Season all your grain offerings with salt. Do not leave the salt of the covenant of your God out of your grain offerings; add salt to all your offerings."** Leviticus 2:13

Father, we come with the salt of the covenant in our hands today. We proclaim that we are Your covenant people. We have renounced the Kingdom of Darkness and have received new life through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We have partaken of the Bread and of the Cup that are symbols of our covenant with the Lord Jesus Christ. It is a covenant of life. Therefore, we sprinkle the salt of the covenant of our God on these memorial stones.

2. **"I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid."** Leviticus 26:6
"I will lie down and sleep, I wake again because the LORD sustains me." Psalm 3:5
"I will lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety." Psalm 4:8

Father, Your covenant with us is one of healing not destruction, so we invoke Your healing power and Your healing presence. The Prince of Darkness uses the night hours to do evil to us. But Your covenant with us includes the night hours. We do not grant those hours to Your enemy. Rather, we claim our covenant with You and ask You now to drive the enemy out of the night. We ask You to heal the night hours and to release your Spirit of peace and security over this city/nation as we sleep. We ask You to heal this portion of our birthright and to restore it to us in holiness.

3. **"The moon will shine like the sun, and the sunlight will be seven times brighter, like the light of seven full days, when the LORD binds up the bruises of his people and heals the wounds he inflicted."** Isaiah 30:26

Father God, we ask You to not only heal the night, but also to heal the light. In the past, because some people have worshipped the sun and the moon, even the light from them has defiled our land with unclean spirits. Now we ask You to heal the light according to Your covenant with us. You wounded us in the past through the heat of the sun without rain. Now Father, heal the wounds You inflicted and release a holy, healing light from the sun and moon onto our land.

4. **"Then the prophet went out to the spring and threw the salt into it, saying, 'This is what the LORD says: 'I have healed this water. Never again will it cause death or make the land unproductive.'" And the water has remained wholesome to this day...** 2 Kings 2:21-22

Father God, our land and the people have been defiled by unclean spirits in the water. We ask You now to heal the water. Heal the water deep below the earth. Heal the water in the pipes and tanks of our city/nation. Let the water be life-giving as You intended. Bless it with such holiness that there is no room left for any defilement. You have given us this water. It is part of our righteous birthright. We humbly ask You to heal the water so we might be healed as well.

5. **"The LORD will grant you abundant prosperity---in the fruit of your womb, the young of your livestock and the crops of your ground---in the land he swore to your forefathers to give you. The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands."** Deuteronomy 28:11-12

Now Father, we ask you to heal our land, the land that we love. We have worked hard for generations and have survived, but we have not prospered. The land has fed us but not with abundance. You are the God who has placed us here in this place. We are here to do some great work for Your Kingdom. We plead our covenant of purpose with You and ask You to heal the land. Give us abundance not for our own selfish use, but so that the world may know that You love us, and so that we can do the Kingdom work to which You have called us.

6. **"Whenever the rainbow appears in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living creatures of every kind on the earth."** Genesis 9:16

We now add these stones to this pile as a memorial to remind us of the covenant of life and healing that we have with the True and Living God.
